

PMI (Purchase Manager Index)

A PMI reading above 50 percent (red line below) indicates that the manufacturing economy is generally expanding and below 50 percent means it is contracting.





Commentary

Economic activity in the manufacturing sector grew in April (albeit at a slower rate than in March), with the overall economy experiencing a 11th consecutive month of growth. New Orders, Production, Employment, Backlog, Prices and Exports & Imports all grew in April and Supplier Deliveries declined at a slower rate, while Raw Materials Inventories and Customer Inventories contracted.

Unemployment Rate

Unemployment rate is traditionally defined as the percentage of the total labor force that is actively looking for gainful employment.





Commentary

In April, the unemployment rate was changed little at 6.1% (from 6.0% in March) and the number of unemployed persons increased slightly to 9.8 million (from 9.7 million in March). Job gains occurred in leisure & hospitality and local government education, while employment declined in temporary help services. Total nonfarm payroll employment increased by 266,000.

Industrial Production and Capacity Utilization

The Production Index (in red below) measures real output and is expressed as a percentage of real output in a base year, currently 2007. The Capacity Index (in green below), which is an estimate of sustainable potential output, is also expressed as a percentage of real output in 2007.





Commentary

Total industrial production increased 0.7% in April. At 106.3% of its 2012 average, the level of total industrial production has increased 16.5% from its trough in April 2020. Manufacturing output rose 0.4% in April, despite a drop in motor vehicle assemblies related to shortages of semiconductors.

Producer Price Index (PPI) and Consumer Price Index (CPI)

The PPI measures the average change over time in prices received (price changes) by producers for domestically produced goods, services and construction. The CPI measures changes in the prices paid by urban consumers for a representative basket of goods and services.

Commentary

CPI for all items increased by 0.8% in April, driven by a 10.0% increase in the index for used cars and trucks. PPI for final demand rose 0.6% in April, as prices for both final demand goods and final demand services both moved up 0.6%.


Comparative Sector Index Performance (Last Twelve Months)

Comparative Subsector LTM EV/Revenue



Commentary

During the last twelve months, our subsector indices had a mean EV/Revenue of 2.3x (i.e., red line) and a median of 1.8x (i.e., yellow line). Of the subsectors, Semiconductor Capital Equipment had the high multiple at 6.4x and Technical Services and Industrial Recycling had the low multiples at 0.7x.

Comparative Subsector LTM EV/EBTIDA



Comparative Subsector LTM Gross Margin



Comparative Subsector LTM EBITDA Margin




Index Subsector LTM EV/EBITDA vs. EBITDA Margin*

Index Subsector LTM EV/EBITDA vs. Gross Margin*









The enterprise value represents a 4.1x multiple on Precise Automation's LTM revenue of \$17 million. Precise Automation provides automation products for electronics, semiconductor, life science, automotive, medical products, and mass storage industries, and as part of the acquisition it is expected to expand the its existing offerings within the Brooks Semiconductor Solutions Group segment.






