

ASGN Incorporated (NYSE:ASGN) reported second quarter net income of \$64.2 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$48.8 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.19 versus \$0.92 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$974.9 million from \$831.9 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Automatic Data Processing, Inc. (NasdaqGS:ADP) reported net income of \$2,598.5 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$2,466.5 million for the prior year. Earnings per share were \$6.07 versus \$5.70 for the prior year. Revenues for the year increased to \$15,005.4 million from \$14,589.8 million for fiscal year 2020.

CBIZ, Inc. (NYSE:CBZ) reported second quarter net income of \$8.6 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$21.5 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.16 versus \$0.39 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$278.6 million from \$236.9 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Computer Task Group, Incorporated (NasdaqGS:CTG) reported second quarter net income of \$1.8 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$1.8 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.12 versus \$0.12 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$92.2 million from \$89.1 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Exponent, Inc. (NasdaqGS:EXPO) reported second quarter net income of \$25.4 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$16.3 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.48 versus \$0.31 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$112.5 million from \$87.9 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

FTI Consulting, Inc. (NYSE:FCN) reported second quarter net income of \$62.8 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$48.2 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.77 versus \$1.27 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$711.5 million from \$607.9 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Heidrick & Struggles International, Inc. (NasdaqGS:HSII) reported second quarter net income of \$20.8 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to (\$25.7) million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.03 versus (\$1.33) for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$260.0 million from \$145.6 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Huron Consulting Group Inc. (NasdaqGS:HURN) reported second quarter net income of \$12.8 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$13.5 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.59 versus \$0.61 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$230.1 million from \$217.9 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

ManpowerGroup Inc. (NYSE:MAN) reported second quarter net income of \$111.6 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to (\$64.4) million for the prior year period. 



Cintas Corporation (NasdaqGS:CTAS) reported net income of \$1,111.0 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$876.0 million for the prior year. Earnings per share were \$10.24 versus \$8.11 for the prior year. Revenues for the year increased to \$7,116.3 million from \$7,085.1 million for fiscal year 2020.

Casella Waste Systems, Inc. (NasdaqGS:CWST) reported second quarter net income of \$11.8 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$12.1 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.23 versus \$0.25 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$215.9 million from \$188.8 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Chemed Corporation (NYSE:CHE) reported second quarter net income of \$56.5 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$82.1 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$3.51 versus \$5.01 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$532.3 million from \$502.2 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Comfort Systems USA, Inc. (NYSE:FIX) reported second quarter net income of \$33.0 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$39.5 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.90 versus \$1.08 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter decreased to \$713.9 million from \$743.5 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

EMCOR Group, Inc. (NYSE:EME) reported second quarter net income of \$97.4 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to (\$83.7) million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.78 versus (\$1.52) for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$2,437.7 million from \$2,014.0 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Healthcare Services Group, Inc. (NasdaqGS:HCSG) reported second quarter net income of \$9.6 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$23.1 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.13 versus \$0.31 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter decreased to \$398.2 million from \$452.0 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Heritage-Crystal Clean, Inc (NasdaqGS:HCCI) reported second quarter net income of \$15.1 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to (\$2.7) million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.02 versus \$0.01 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$989.4 million from \$958.0 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Rollins, Inc. (NYSE:ROL) reported second quarter net income of \$98.9 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$75.4 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.20 versus \$0.15 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$638.2 million from \$553.3 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Rentokil Initial plc (LSE:RTO) reported second quarter net income of \$82.3 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$29.2 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.04 versus \$0.02 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$1,010.1 million from \$799.2 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Sodexo S.A. (ENXTPA:SW) reported second quarter net income of \$20.0 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$207.9 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.13 versus \$1.40 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter decreased to \$5,199.6 million from \$6,429.1 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Securitas AB (OM:SECU B) reported second quarter net income of \$89.2 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$58.7 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.24 versus \$0.16 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$3,097.6 million from \$2,855.3 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Republic Services, Inc. (NYSE:RSG) reported second quarter net income of \$331.1 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$225.5 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.03 versus \$0.71 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$2,812.8 million from \$2,454.4 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

SP Plus Corporation (NasdaqGS:SP) reported second quarter net income of \$9.0 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to (\$39.1) million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.42 versus (\$1.86) for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$141.2 million from \$93.0 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.
