

AMN Healthcare Services, Inc. (NYSE:AMN) reported second quarter net income of \$66.8 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$22.3 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.39 versus \$0.47 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$857.4 million from \$608.4 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Cross Country Healthcare, Inc. (NasdaqGS:CCRN) reported second quarter net income of \$11.5 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to (\$14.2) million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.31 versus (\$0.39) for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$331.8 million from \$216.8 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Barrett Business Services, Inc. (NasdaqGS:BBSI) reported second quarter net income of \$17.1 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$11.5 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$2.24 versus \$1.51 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$233.2 million from \$201.0 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

CRA International, Inc. (NasdaqGS:CRAI) reported second quarter net income of \$11.6 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$5.9 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.53 versus \$0.75 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$148.2 million from \$123.0 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

Hudson Global, Inc. (NasdaqGS:HSON) reported second quarter net income of (\$0.1) million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to (\$0.8) million for the prior year period. Insperity, Inc. (NYSE:NSP) reported second quarter net income of \$25.2 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$51.9 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.65 versus \$1.33 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$1,185.4 million from \$993.4 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Kelly Services, Inc. (NasdaqGS:KELY.A) reported second quarter net income of \$24.0 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$41.1 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.60 versus \$1.04 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$1,258.1 million from \$975.3 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.





Aramark (NYSE:ARMK) reported third quarter net income of \$32.6 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to (\$256.4) million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.13 versus (\$1.01) for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$2,981.2 million from \$2,152.3 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Clean Harbors, Inc. (NYSE:CLH) reported second quarter net income of \$67.1 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$29.0 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.22 versus \$0.52 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$926.5 million from \$710.0 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Colliers International Group Inc. (TSX:CIGI) reported second quarter net income of (\$456.1) million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to (\$10.3) million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were (\$10.53) versus (\$0.26) for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$946.0 million from \$550.2 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

CoreCivic, Inc. (NYSE:CXW) reported second quarter net income of \$15.6 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$22.2 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.13 versus \$0.18 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter decreased to \$464.6 million from \$472.6 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Jacobs Engineering Group Inc. (NYSE:J) reported third quarter net income of \$165.8 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$244.9 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.83 versus \$1.87 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$3,576.4 million from \$3,260.1 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Stericycle, Inc. (NasdaqGS:SRCL) reported second quarter net income of \$29.3 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to (\$4.5) million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.32 versus (\$0.05) for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$672.7 million from \$598.2 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

The GEO Group, Inc. (NYSE:GEO) reported second quarter net income of \$42.0 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$36.7 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.29 versus \$0.31 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter decreased to \$565.4 million from \$587.8 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Waste Connections, Inc. (NYSE:WCN) reported second quarter net income of \$177.0 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to (\$227.1) million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.68 versus (\$0.86) for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$1,533.9 million from \$1,305.8 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.
