

A PMI reading above 50 percent (red line below) indicates that the manufacturing economy is generally expanding and below 50 percent means it is contracting.





Commentary

Economic activity in the manufacturing sector grew in November, with the overall economy experiencing a 18th consecutive month of growth. New Orders, Production, Employment, Backlog, Raw Materials Inventories, and Exports all grew in November but Supplier Deliveries declined at a slower rate.

Industrial Production and Capacity Utilization

The Production Index (in red below) measures real output and is expressed as a percentage of real output in a base year, currently 2007. The Capacity Index (in green below), which is an estimate of sustainable potential output, is also expressed as a percentage of real output in 2007.



Commentary

Industrial production rose 0.5 percent in November. At 102.3 percent of its 2017 average, total industrial production in November was 5.3 percent above its year-earlier level and at its highest reading since September 2019. Capacity utilization for the industrial sector increased 0.3 percentage point to 76.8 percent; even so, it was 2.8 percentage points below its long-term (1972–2020) average.

Unemployment Rate

Unemployment rate is traditionally defined as the percentage of the total labor force that is actively looking for gainful employment.





Commentary

In November, the unemployment rate declined by 0.4% to 4.2% and the number of unemployed persons fell to 6.9 million. Notable job gains in occurred in professional and business services, transportation and warehousing, construction, and manufacturing. Total nonfarm payroll employment increased by 210,000.

Producer Price Index (PPI) and Consumer Price Index (CPI)

The PPI measures the average change over time in prices received (price changes) by producers for domestically produced goods, services and construction. The CPI measures changes in the prices paid by urban consumers for a representative basket of goods and services.


Commentary

CPI for all items increased by 0.8% in November, driven by increases in the energy, shelter, food, used cars and trucks, and new vehicles indexes. PPI for final demand also rose 0.8% in November, driven by a 1.2% increase in prices for final demand goods and a 0.7% increase in the index for final demand services.




Last Three Years

Daily from November 30, 2018 to November 30, 2021 Price as Percent of Base (November 30, 2018 = 0%)





Comparative Subsector LTM EV/Revenue



Commentary


Comparative Subsector LTM EV/EBTIDA


Comparative Subsector LTM Gross Margin

Comparative Subsector LTM EBITDA Margin





Index Subsector LTM EV/EBITDA vs. EBITDA Margin*








