


Historical Enterprise Value-to-LTM EBITDA Multiples

ARYZTA AG (SWX:ARYN) reported net income of (\$279.7) million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to (\$1,291.3) million for the prior year. Earnings per share were (\$0.34) versus (\$1.36) for the prior year. Revenues for the year decreased to \$1,809.5 million from \$1,974.4 million for fiscal year 2020.

Associated British Foods plc (LSE: ABF) reported net income of \$657.4 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$581.6 million for the prior year. Earnings per share were \$0.83 versus \$0.74 for the prior year. Revenues for the year increased to \$19,095.8 million from \$17,815.0 million for fiscal year 2020.

B&G Foods, Inc. (**BGS**) reported third quarter net income of \$20.7 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$46.8 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.32 versus \$0.72 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$515.0 million from \$495.8 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

Cal-Maine Foods, Inc. (CALM) reported second quarter net income of \$1.2 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$12.2 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.02 versus \$0.25 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$390.9 million from \$347.3 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

Campbell Soup Company (**CPB**) reported first quarter net income of \$261.0 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$309.0 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.86 versus \$1.02 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter decreased to \$2,236.0 million from \$2,340.0 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

Conagra Brands, Inc. (CAG) reported first quarter net income of \$235.4 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$329.0 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.49 versus \$0.67 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter decreased to \$2,653.3 million from \$2,678.9 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

Flowers Foods, Inc. (**FLO**) reported third quarter net income of \$38.9 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$44.3 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.18 versus \$0.21 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$1,027.8 million from \$989.7 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

General Mills, Inc. (GIS) reported second quarter net income of \$597.2 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$688.4 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.97 versus \$1.11 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$5,024.0 million from \$4,719.4 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

George Weston Limited (TSX:WN) reported third quarter net income of \$110.7 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$238.2 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.66 versus \$1.47 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$12,984.6 million from \$11,878.9 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Grupo Bimbo, S.A.B. de C.V. (BMV:BIMBO A) reported third quarter net income of \$196.6 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$163.1 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.05 versus \$0.04 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$4,302.3 million from \$3,882.6 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Hormel Foods Corporation (HRL) reported net income of \$908.8 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$908.1 million for the prior year. Earnings per share were \$1.66 versus \$1.66 for the prior year. Revenues for the year increased to \$11,386.2 million from \$9,608.5 million for fiscal year 2020.

Hostess Brands, Inc. (TWNK) reported third quarter net income of \$26.2 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$24.9 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.19 versus \$0.18 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$288.0 million from \$260.9 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

J & J Snack Foods Corp. (JJSF) reported net income of \$55.6 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$18.3 million for the prior year. Earnings per share were \$2.91 versus \$0.96 for the prior year. Revenues for the year increased to \$1,144.6 million from \$1,022.0 million for fiscal year 2020.

JBS S.A. (**BOVESPA:JBSS3**) reported third quarter net income of \$1,398.9 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$557.6 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.55 versus \$0.21 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$17,081.3 million from \$12,474.2 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

John B. Sanfilippo & Son, Inc. (**JBSS**) reported first quarter net income of \$19.2 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$12.8 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.66 versus \$1.11 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$226.3 million from \$210.3 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

Kellogg Company (**K**) reported third quarter net income of \$307.0 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$348.0 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.89 versus \$1.01 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$3,622.0 million from \$3,429.0 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

Lamb Weston Holdings, Inc. (**LW**) reported first quarter net income of \$29.8 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$89.3 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.20 versus \$0.61 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$984.2 million from \$871.5 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

Lancaster Colony Corporation (LANC) reported first quarter net income of \$30.7 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$37.1 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.11 versus \$1.35 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$392.1 million from \$349.2 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

Mondelez International, Inc. (MDLZ) reported third quarter net income of \$1,258.0 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$1,119.0 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.89 versus \$0.78 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$7,182.0 million from \$6,665.0 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Nestlé S.A. (**SWX:NESN**) reported second quarter net income of \$3,215.1 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$3,105.9 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.15 versus \$1.08 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$22,674.0 million from \$21,805.9 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.

Nomad Foods Limited (NOMD) reported third quarter net income of \$59.9 million for fiscal year 2021 as compared to \$66.2 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.34 versus \$0.34 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$694.7 million from \$676.7 million for the same period in fiscal year 2020.







Historical Enterprise Value-to-LTM EBITDA Multiples


