

Huron Consulting Group Inc. (NasdaqGS:HURN) reported first quarter net income of \$26.9 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$5.4 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.27 versus \$0.24 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$260.0 million from \$203.2 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

Kelly Services, Inc. (NasdaqGS:KELY.A) reported first quarter net income of (\$47.6) million for fiscal year 2023 as compared to \$25.6 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were (\$1.23) versus \$0.64 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$1,296.4 million from \$1,205.9 million for the same period in fiscal year 2022.

Kforce Inc. (NasdaqGS:KFRC) reported first quarter net income of \$19.2 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$13.3 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.93 versus \$0.62 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$417.0 million from \$363.2 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

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

Selected News Fixed Asset Management

Aramark (NYSE:ARMK) reported second quarter net income of \$35.7 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to (\$77.6) million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.14 versus (\$0.30) for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$3,860.5 million from \$2,819.7 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

Clean Harbors, Inc. (NYSE:CLH) reported first quarter net income of \$45.3 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$21.7 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.83 versus \$0.39 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$1,169.1 million from \$808.1 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

Colliers International Group Inc. (**TSX:CIGI**) reported first quarter net income of (\$18.6) million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$4.5 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were (\$0.42) versus \$0.11 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$1,000.9 million from \$774.9 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

Compass Group PLC (LSE:CPG) reported second quarter net income of \$313.5 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$68.9 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.18 versus \$0.04 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$7,557.8 million from \$5,810.2 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

CoreCivic, Inc. (**NYSE:CXW**) reported first quarter net income of \$19.0 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to (\$125.6) million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.16 versus (\$1.05) for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter decreased to \$453.0 million from \$454.7 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

Heritage-Crystal Clean, Inc (NasdaqGS:HCCI) reported first quarter net income of \$12.9 million for fiscal year 2023 as compared to \$9.2 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.54 versus \$0.39 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$139.4 million from \$105.4 million for the same period in fiscal year 2022.

Jacobs Engineering Group Inc. (NYSE:J) reported second quarter net income of \$88.8 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$11.0 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.68 versus \$0.08 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$3,834.1 million from \$3,547.9 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

Prosegur Compañía de Seguridad, S.A. (BME:PSG) reported first quarter net income of \$11.8 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$20.0 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.02 versus (\$0.00) for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$1,051.9 million from \$942.5 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

Republic Services, Inc. (NYSE:RSG) reported first quarter net income of \$352.0 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$295.9 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.11 versus \$0.93 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$2,968.8 million from \$2,595.9 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

Securitas AB (publ) (OM:SECU B) reported first quarter net income of \$89.8 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$77.9 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.25 versus \$0.21 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$3,062.3 million from \$2,959.8 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

SP Plus Corporation (NasdaqGS:SP) reported first quarter net income of \$10.7 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$2.3 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.50 versus \$0.11 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$184.4 million from \$128.7 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

The Brink's Company (NYSE:BCO) reported first quarter net income of \$71.3 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$12.7 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.48 versus \$0.25 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$1,074.0 million from \$977.7 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

The GEO Group, Inc. (NYSE:GEO) reported first quarter net income of \$38.2 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$50.5 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.26 versus \$0.41 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter decreased to \$551.2 million from \$576.4 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.

Waste Connections, Inc. (**NYSE:WCN**) reported first quarter net income of \$180.3 million for fiscal year 2022 as compared to \$160.3 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.69 versus \$0.61 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$1,646.3 million from \$1,395.9 million for the same period in fiscal year 2021.
