



ASGN Incorporated (NYSE:ASGN) reported first quarter net income of \$38.1 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$49.5 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.81 versus \$0.99 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter decreased to \$1,049.0 million from \$1,128.8 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.

CBIZ, Inc. (**NYSE:CBZ**) reported first quarter net income of \$76.9 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$73.2 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.53 versus \$1.44 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$494.3 million from \$454.6 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.

Exponent, Inc. (NasdaqGS:EXPO) reported first quarter net income of \$30.1 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$29.1 million for the prior year period. 



Casella Waste Systems, Inc. (NasdaqGS:CWST) reported first quarter net income of (\$4.1) million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$3.5 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were (\$0.07) versus \$0.07 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$341.0 million from \$262.6 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.

Chemed Corporation (NYSE:CHE) reported first quarter net income of \$65.0 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$54.1 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$4.24 versus \$3.58 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$589.2 million from \$560.2 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.

Earnings per share were \$4.17 versus \$2.32 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$3,432.3 million from \$2,890.4 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.

Healthcare Services Group, Inc. (NasdaqGS:HCSG) reported first quarter net income of \$15.3 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$11.7 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.21 versus \$0.16 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$423.4 million from \$417.2 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.


