

#### **Selected News**

**Huron Consulting Group Inc.** (NasdaqGS:HURN) reported third quarter net income of \$27.1 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$21.5 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.47 versus \$1.10 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$370.0 million from \$358.2 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.

**Insperity, Inc. (NYSE:NSP)** reported third quarter net income of \$3.0 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$44.3 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.07 versus \$1.16 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$1,561.0 million from \$1,550.9 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.

**Paychex, Inc.** (NasdaqGS:PAYX) reported first quarter net income of \$427.4 million for fiscal year 2025 as compared to \$419.2 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.18 versus \$1.16 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$1,318.5 million from \$1,286.0 million for the same period in fiscal year 2024.

**ManpowerGroup Inc.** (NYSE:MAN) reported third quarter net income of \$22.8 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$30.3 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.47 versus \$0.60 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter decreased to \$4,530.2 million from \$4,675.6 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.

**Robert Half Inc.** (NYSE:RHI) reported third quarter net income of \$65.5 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$95.5 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.64 versus \$0.90 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter decreased to \$1,465.0 million from \$1,563.8 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.

**TriNet Group, Inc. (NYSE:TNET)** reported third quarter net income of \$45.0 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$94.0 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.89 versus \$1.63 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$1,237.0 million from \$1,222.0 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.



Casella Waste Systems, Inc. (NasdaqGS:CWST) reported third quarter net income of \$5.8 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$18.2 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.10 versus \$0.31 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$411.6 million from \$352.7 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.

**Chemed Corporation (NYSE:CHE)** reported third quarter net income of \$75.8 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$75.0 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$5.00 versus \$4.93 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$606.2 million from \$564.5 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.

**Clean Harbors, Inc. (NYSE:CLH)** reported third quarter net income of \$115.2 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$91.3 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$2.12 versus \$1.68 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$1,529.4 million from \$1,365.7 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.

Comfort Systems USA, Inc. (NYSE:FIX) reported third quarter net income of \$146.2 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$105.1 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$4.09 versus \$2.93 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$1,812.4 million from \$1,378.1 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.

**EMCOR Group, Inc. (NYSE:EME)** reported third quarter net income of \$270.3 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$169.4 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$5.80 versus \$3.57 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$3,696.9 million from \$3,207.6 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.

**Healthcare Services Group, Inc. (NasdaqGS:HCSG)** reported third quarter net income of \$14.0 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to (\$5.0) million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.19 versus (\$0.07) for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$428.1 million from \$411.4 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.

**Republic Services, Inc. (NYSE:RSG)** reported third quarter net income of \$565.7 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$480.2 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.80 versus \$1.52 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$4,076.2 million from \$3,825.9 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.

**Rollins, Inc. (NYSE:ROL)** reported third quarter net income of \$136.9 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$127.8 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$0.28 versus \$0.26 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$916.3 million from \$840.4 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.

**Sodexo S.A.** (ENXTPA:SW) reported net income of \$185.8 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$861.2 million for the prior year. Earnings per share were \$1.25 versus \$5.84 for the prior year. Revenues for the year increased to \$26,322.3 million from \$24,552.1 million for fiscal year 2023.

**UniFirst Corporation (NYSE:UNF)** reported net income of \$145.5 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$103.7 million for the prior year. Earnings per share were \$7.77 versus \$5.53 for the prior year. Revenues for the year increased to \$2,427.4 million from \$2,233.0 million for fiscal year 2023.

**Waste Connections, Inc. (NYSE:WCN)** reported third quarter net income of \$308.0 million for fiscal year 2024 as compared to \$229.0 million for the prior year period. Earnings per share were \$1.19 versus \$0.89 for the prior year period. Revenues for the quarter increased to \$2,338.5 million from \$2,064.7 million for the same period in fiscal year 2023.




